Learning Methods

We will employ a variety of methods to engage in learning:

- 1. **Monthly Board Meeting Sessions**: Dedicate one hour in each monthly board meeting to a specific topic
- 2. Quarterly Work Sessions: Half-day deep dives into complex issues
- 3. **Annual Retreat**: Two-day intensive focusing on long-term strategy and policy development
- 4. **Site Visits**: Visits to high-performing schools or innovative programs
- 5. **Expert Panels**: Panel discussions with subject matter experts as a part of our Board meeting routine
- 6. Community Listening Sessions: Quarterly town halls or focus groups with stakeholders
- 7. **Online Learning**: Monthly webinars or virtual workshops on emerging trends
- 8. Commissioned Reports: Bi-annual contracted studies on specific topics
- 9. **Book Club**: Bi-monthly discussions on relevant educational literature
- 10. Conference Attendance: Annual participation in national charter school conferences
